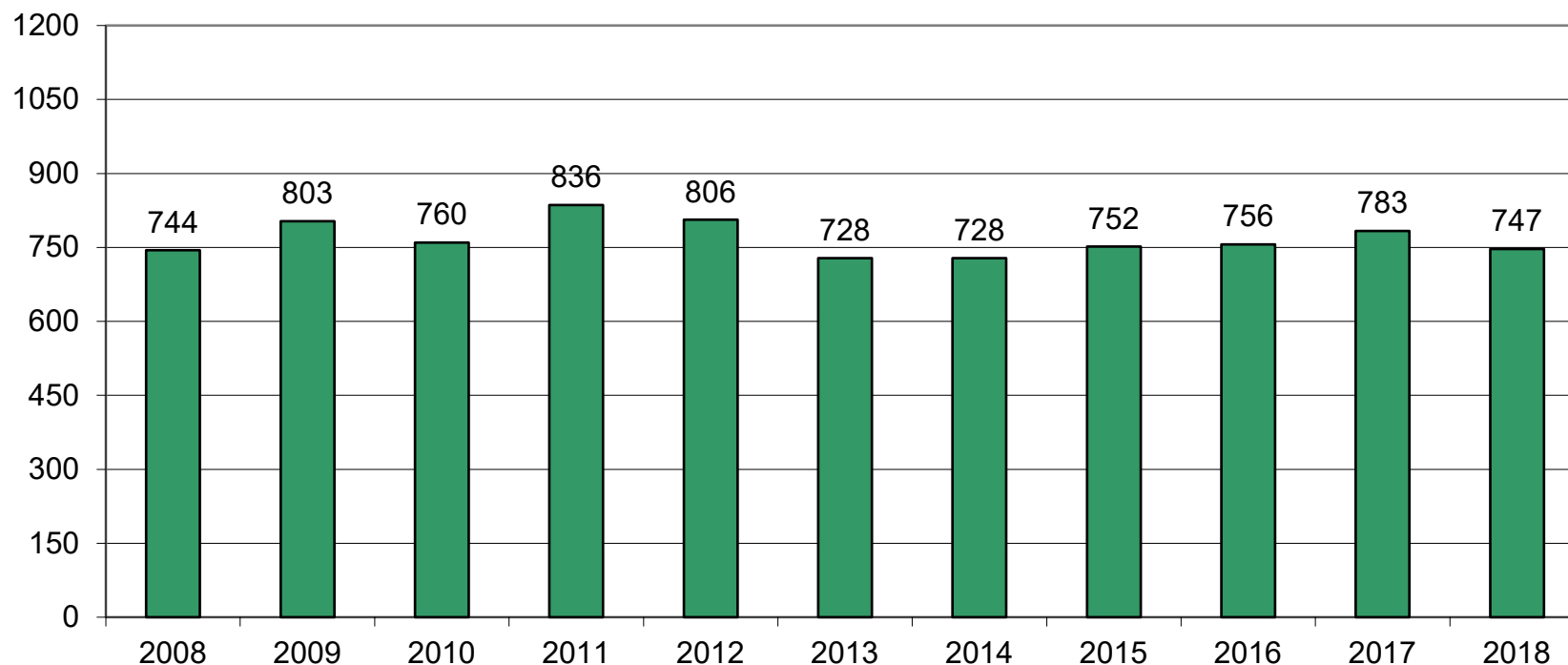

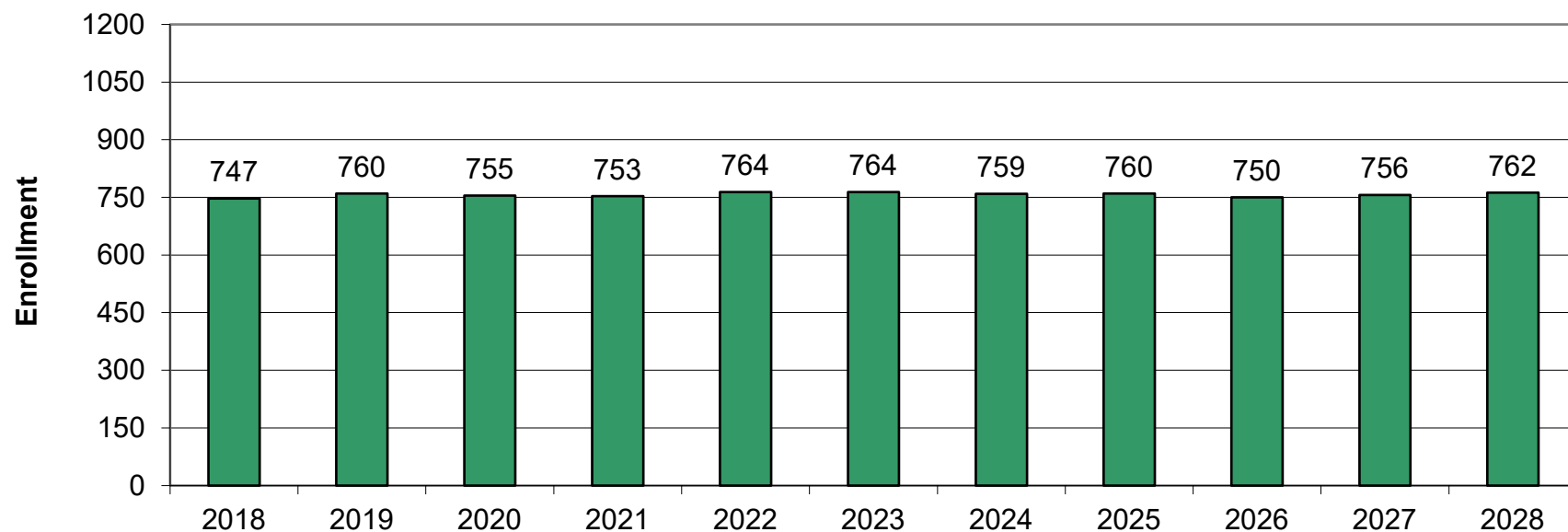

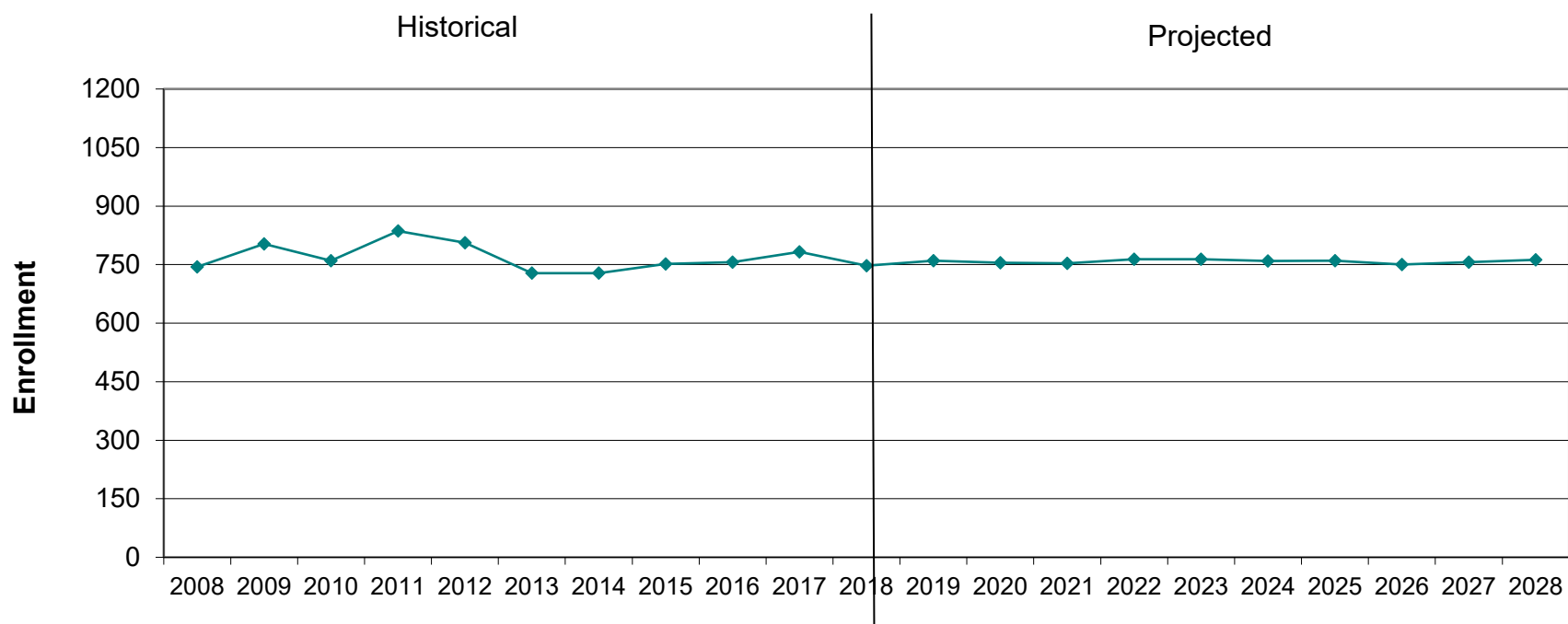
Winooski, VT Projected Enrollment

K-12 To 2029 Based On Data Through School Year 2018-19

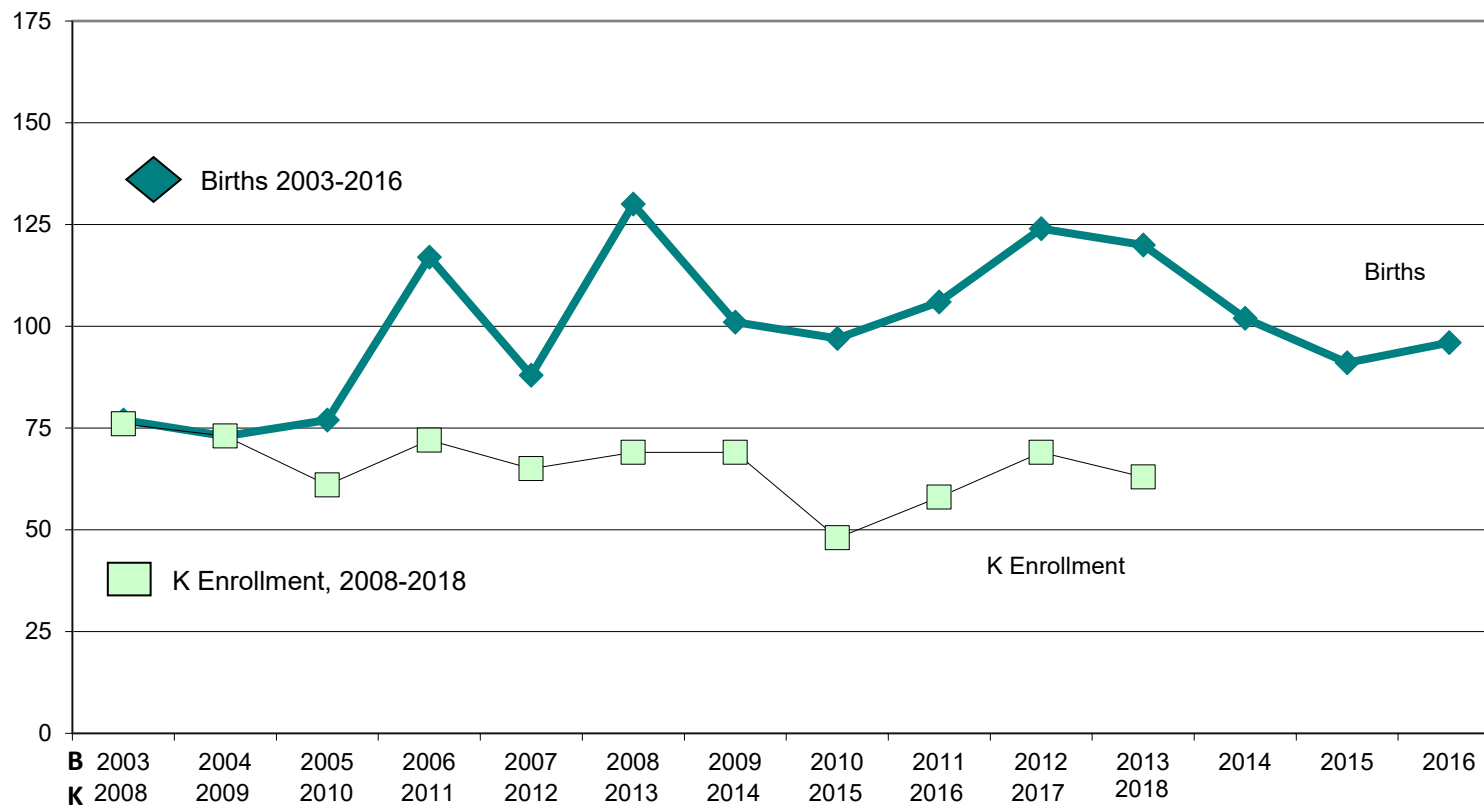


Winooski, VT Historical & Projected Enrollment
