# **How Will It Affect My Taxes?**

### This depends on Household Income:

- If below \$99,000 it is based on a Flat Rate
  - 2.23% in FY19 & 2.34% in FY20
- If between \$99,000 & \$147,500 it is based on House Value with some degree of Income Sensitivity
- If above \$147,500 it is solely based on House Value
