- 4. Online fundraising is allowed by students and adults
- 5. It is perfectly acceptable to hoard money and add it all to a jar(s) last minute
- 6. Students from any grade level in WSD can add money to the jars. Adults too!

Pokemon Cards

Students have begun to bring Pokémon cards into school and they are causing disruptions to the learning environment. Moving forward we will have the same expectations for Pokémon cards that we do for personal electronics (cell phones etc.):

- 1. Away during the day in a locker or given to a trusted adult to hold for the day
- 2. If a student takes the cards out while they are in the school building, an adult will take the cards and give them back at the end of the day
