SEL Curriculum Update

In March and April, our K-2 School Counselor will be teaching lessons from the <u>Care for Kids</u> program. This is the portion of our S.E.L. curriculum that teaches students how to recognize and prevent child sexual abuse. All Vermont schools are required to cover this important topic as outlined in Vermont state legislation known as Act 1.

This is the general overview of the <u>Care for Kids</u> topics:

<u>Asking for Help:</u> Children identify the adults who can help them. If one adult does not help them, they are encouraged to ask other adults until they get the help that they need.

<u>Touching:</u> Sometimes we like to be touched and sometimes we don't. Everyone has the right to say "no" to touching and we do not touch a person who says "no."

<u>Feelings:</u> Children discuss times when they are not sure what they are feeling. These feelings are identified as "mixed-up" feelings. We discuss what they can do if they feel scared or have mixed-up feelings.

<u>Bodies:</u> Children learn the anatomically correct names of body parts including parts that are considered private. We discuss that no one should see or touch the private parts of their body and no one should ask them to see or touch the private parts of the other person's body.

<u>Babies:</u> Children discuss the ways that they needed help with their bodies when they were babies. We discuss what they can do by themselves now and ways in which they still need help from trusted adults.

We encourage you to talk to your child about these important topics. Please feel free to contact our School Counselor, Grace Holcomb, if you have any questions.

Our 3-5 Counselor will be teaching lessons from The Healthy Relationships Project curriculum after the April Vacation. We will share more information in an upcoming newsletter.
