

Audience Agreements

H onest	Own your actions Clap or sit quietly Ask for what you need Come prepared to participate
E ngaged	Be a positive audience member Active, whole body listening Listen to and look at the speaker Come prepared to participate
A ppropriate	Use safe bodies and kind words Follow audience protocols and etiquette Stay seated (chair or floor) or safely in your space until dismissed Be mindful of others' space and experience
R esponsible	Take care of school and personal property Walk safely Stay in your assigned spot Be responsible for the needs of all students (accommodations) Clean up after yourself and keep the space clean
T imely	Be mindful of everyone's schedule Return quickly if you need to leave

JFK Audience Expectations / Rules

For Students

- Sit safely in your spot until dismissed
- Use kind words and respectful actions
- Clap at the right times or sit quietly
- Listen to and look at the speaker
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Take care of school property

- Return quickly if you need to leave

For Adults

- Actively supervise students and move around as needed
- Reinforce agreements and expectations with positive reminders
- Model positive audience behavior
- Sit with students when support is needed
- Help reinforce expectations calmly and consistently
- Monitor student needs (seating, movement, accommodations)
- Step in early to redirect unsafe or disruptive behavior
- Support smooth transitions in and out of assemblies
- Communicate with colleagues if additional support is needed
