

Bus Agreements

Honest

I own my actions.
I ask for what I need from the bus monitor or peers.
I follow my dismissal plan.

Engaged

I stay seated and face forward.
I stay in my seat until the bus stops
I know my bus number.
I have quiet conversations with my seatmate or across the aisle.

Appropriate

I keep my body safe and stay in my personal space.
I use kind words and an inside voice.
I keep my belongings and food in my backpack.

Responsible

I clean up after myself.
I take care of school and personal property.
I follow the bus monitor's directions.
I gather my things before the bus stops.

Timely

I follow directions the first time.
I sit down quickly when boarding and get off the bus promptly when signaled.

JFK Bus Expectations / Rules

Student Rules

- Stay in your assigned seat and face forward at all times.
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- Use a quiet voice and kind words.
- Raise your hand if you need help from the bus monitor.
- Keep all food and drinks in your backpack.
- Take care of your belongings and the bus.
- Follow the bus monitor's directions the first time.
- Gather your things and be ready before the bus stops.
- Sit down quickly when boarding and get off quickly when it's your turn.
- Stay in your seat until the bus comes to a full stop.

Adult Rules

- Actively supervise students while moving around the bus if necessary.
- Reinforce bus agreements and expectations with positive reminders.
- Ensure smooth, timely boarding and dismissal.
- Support safety and proper use of the bus.
- Ensure that PK and K students have an adult or older student to get them off the bus
- Ensure PK and K students have an adult or older student to meet them at the bus stop.
- If a PK or K student does not have an adult or older student present, keep the student on the bus and return them to school. Text administration to notify them that the student is being brought back.
