Finishing Our School-Wide Agreements Series: Audience Agreements in Action!

This week, we're wrapping up our series on school-wide agreements by sharing our Audience Agreements. Last week, our students had a fantastic opportunity to put these agreements into practice during the 6th Grade Circus Performance!



Our agreements focus on helping students be:

Honest: Own your actions, clap or sit quietly, ask for what you need, and come prepared to participate.

Engaged: Be a positive audience member, actively listen with your whole body, and focus on the speaker.

Appropriate: Use safe bodies and kind words, follow audience protocols, stay in your spot, and respect others' space.

Responsible: Take care of school and personal property, stay in your assigned spot, be mindful of

everyone's needs, and clean up after yourself.

Timely: Be mindful of everyone's schedule and return quickly if you need to leave.

Watching the 6th graders' circus performance was a wonderful way for our students to practice these skills and celebrate learning together. We are so proud of how thoughtfully our students followed these agreements—and we can't wait to see them continue to bring them into every classroom and assembly!
