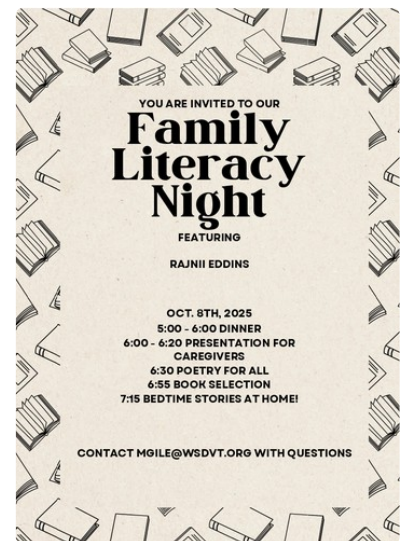
You're Invited to Family Literacy Night!

JFK Schoolwide HEART Agreements - Bus

The first several weeks of school have been filled with opportunities for students to learn, connect, and practice our HEART agreements throughout JFK. These agreements provide clear guidance for behavior in all shared spaces, including the cafeteria, playground, hallways, buses, bathrooms, and

during assemblies or other group events. By integrating these expectations into everyday routines, students are forming habits that support a positive and respectful school community.



This week, we are highlighting our Bus HEART agreements for families. On the bus, students are focusing on riding safely, being aware of those around them, and following directions from the bus monitor without delay. Key practices include remaining seated, keeping personal space, speaking quietly, and taking care of personal and school property. Staff work alongside students to model these behaviors, provide gentle reminders, and ensure that boarding and dismissal happen efficiently and safely. Families can support this learning by reviewing the bus expectations with their children at home. The Bus Agreements document is attached to this newsletter for you to reference.
