ARTICLES

ARTICLE THREE

Shall the voters of the City of Winooski approve the budget for the Fiscal Year 2027 in the amount of Eleven Million Nine Hundred Eight Thousand Forty-Two Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$11,908,042.54). The amount to be raised from property taxes is Nine Million Three Hundred Nineteen Thousand Sixty-Five Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$9,319,065.79).

ARTICLE FOUR

Shall the City Council be authorized to apply for and accept funds from sources other than property taxation, and to expend the same for the benefit of the City in addition to sums for which budget appropriation has been made? (Approval of this article will not impact property taxes.)

ARTICLE FIVE

Shall general obligation bonds of the City of Winooski in a principal amount not to exceed Five Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$580,000) be issued for the planning, design, construction, repair, replacement, and upgrade of the Cascade Parking Garage elevator and related capital improvements? A portion of the repayment is intended to come from parking fees, subject to any reduction for applicable state and federal grants-in-aid and any applicable general funds but backed by the full faith and credit of the City.

Shall general obligation bonds of the City of Winooski in a principal amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) be issued for the planning, design, construction, and installation of a sidewalk on a portion of East Spring Street and related capital improvements, with the total amount of such general obligation bonds to be reduced by the receipt of state and federal grants-in-aid?

ARTICLE SIX

Shall the voters of the Winooski School District authorize the School Board to use existing funds from the prior year surplus to purchase the property adjacent to the school district at two (2) Normand Street for school purposes at an amount not to exceed Three Hundred and Eighty Thousand dollars (380,000)

ARTICLE SEVEN

Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend Thirty-Four Million, Eight Hundred and Eighteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and Nine dollars (\$34,818,909), which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Winooski School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$14,899, which is 2.4% lower than per pupil education spending for the current year.
